High School Field Trip

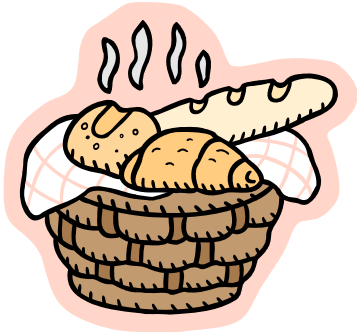
7th-12th Grade
