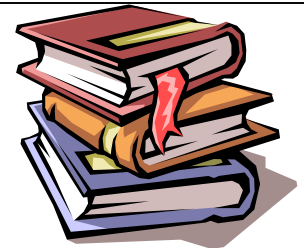

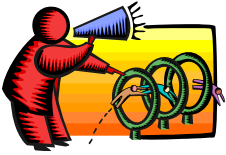

**Our Baseball and Softball season has begun. Our teams have been practicing to get ready for the games. We will be cheering on all of our players.**

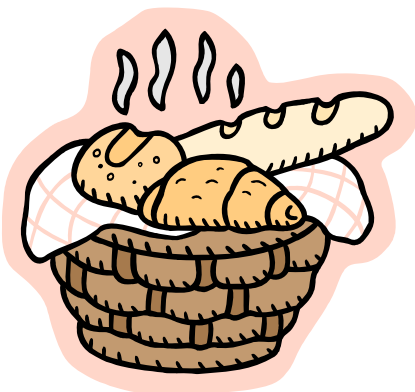
