## Lunch Auction Update

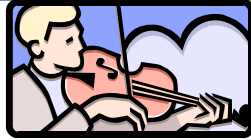

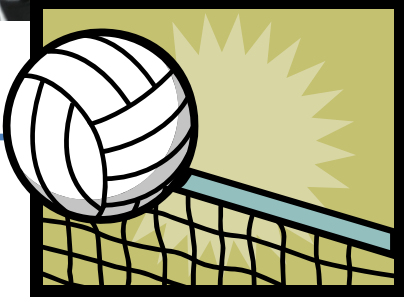
