



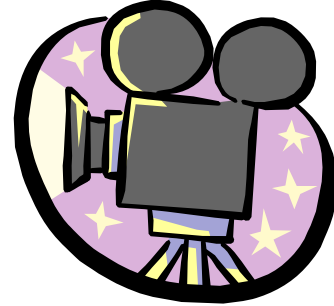

Parents, please check the office for lost and found articles. There is a huge pile of items that have been turned in.

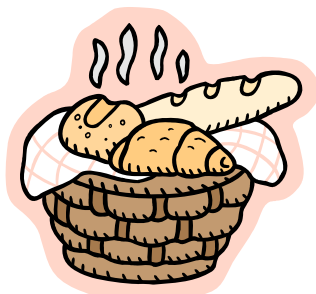


## SPORTS AUCTION UPDATE

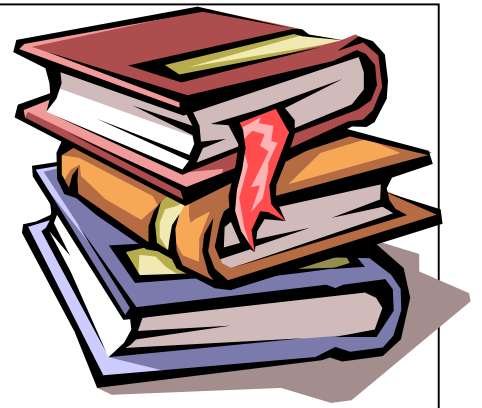
