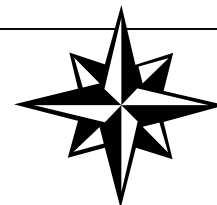

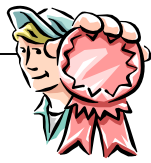
On December 12, 2009, at 12:00 P.M. HCS will be in the Luthersville Christmas parade.

HCS donated over 500 canned goods to One Roof, the Coweta county food bank. We were one of the seven schools to contribute. Thank you for all your support!

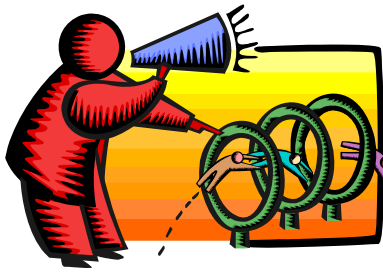

5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade also won the “Most Spirit” and “Best Cheer” contest.

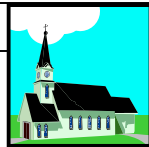
With the walls decorated and everyone pumped up for the basketball season, it looks like our season will be a great one.

Both grades will receive a free ice-cream party for their efforts.

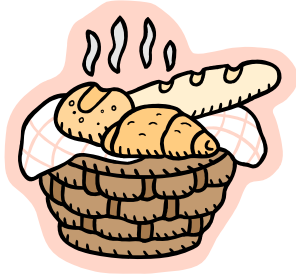
Thus far we have received \$250.00 for collecting the box tops. Keep sending them in!

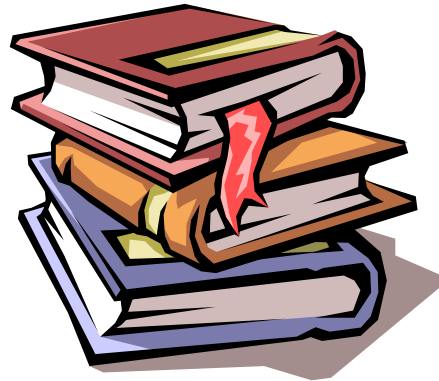

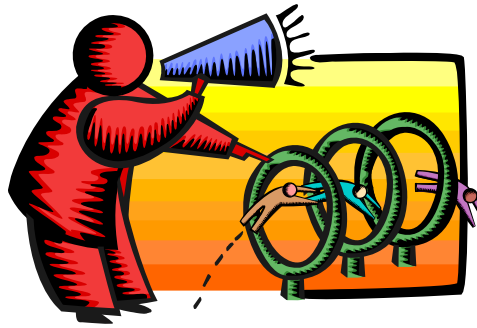
